

UNSW Business School School of Economics

The School of Economics is seeking Leaders for the Peer Assisted Support Scheme (PASS) in 2018.

Applications are now open for positions as:

1. Quant PASS leaders for ECON1202, ECON1203 and ECON2206 and some similar postgraduate courses.
2. Econ PASS leaders for ECON1101 and ECON1102.

Quant PASS leaders will run study support groups in Business and Economic Statistics (BES), Quantitative Analysis for Business and Economics (QABE), Introductory Econometrics and possibly some similar postgraduate courses. Hours are likely to vary in both semesters due to the level of enrolments.

Applicants for Quant PASS positions are required to have gained a grade of at least 75 in BES and any of the other courses for which they wish to be considered by the end of semester 2 2017. Approximately 10 new leaders are required.

Econ PASS leaders will run study groups in either Micro 1 or Macro 1 and need to have gained a grade of at least 75 in these courses by the end of semester 2 2017 in order to be eligible to apply. Approximately 5 new leaders are required.

Interviews for leader positions will be held on Monday 27 November or Tuesday 28 November. Interviewees will be contacted by phone or email as soon as possible after the closing date (November 17) to arrange a suitable time.

Successful applicants must be available to take part in training for two days in the week prior to 0 Week in February 2018. Once semester 1 begins leaders will be required to attend a regular weekly meeting and to prepare for and run one or more weekly study groups. PASS requires both commitment from leaders and enough flexibility in their timetables to organise meeting and class times. This flexibility is difficult to achieve for those who have more than one day of work arranged in addition to their PASS and study commitments. We are not able to consider those who work for two or more whole weekdays per week.
