If you have successfully completed the **first 2 years of the Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) program** at VNUIU, you may apply to enter the **Bachelor of Commerce** at the UNSW Australia Business School, and be granted advanced standing. Credit of up to **48 Units of Credit (UOC) / 8 courses (equivalent to 1 year)** may be awarded on the basis that:

- You achieve a minimum **CGPA of 70** out of 100 in the first 2 years at VNUIU; AND
- You achieve a minimum IELTS score of 6.5 overall, with a minimum of 6.0 in each subtest (or equivalent English Language Test or University English Preparation Course results as detailed at www.unsw.edu.au/elp).
